### DIRECTIONS

**Smashes:**

Release blanket clamp at end nearest to smash to expose fabric back. Blanket need not be completely removed. Mark smashed area on fabric back with a pencil. Apply **PBR** with a clean cloth. Rub **PBR** into damaged fabric area plus a 1" margin around the damaged area until a foaming action appears (approx. 1 minute). Remove excess **PBR** with a clean, dry cloth. Re- clamp blanket and begin printing immediately.

**Pre-treatment:**

Soak cloth with **PBR**. Wipe entire back of new fabric-backed blanket, scrubbing uniformly until foaming appears. Remove excess with clean, dry cloth. Pack .001" less than usual. Mount blanket and print.
